Shoulder Harnesses Required for Firefighting Aircraft


Under new rules announced by the U.S. Forestry Service, all aircraft engaged in firefighting operations must be equipped with suitable shoulder harnesses by the start of the 2025 fire season.

In order to help operators prepare, Twin Commander has developed **Custom Kit 208**. The kit includes all the hardware necessary and belts to add shoulder harnesses to the two middle passenger seats in the forward and rear-facing configuration, and the two outer seats on the rear bench.

Passenger Shoulder Harness

Initially effective for these Models: 690/A/B/C and 695 Additional models to follow Provides additional adjustable fixed Shoulder Harness for passenger seating. Increases levels of safety during turbulence, take off, taxi, and landing.

Shoulder Harness installations can accommodate a range of seating floor plans for aft and forward-facing seats.




CK208-1 covers the 690 platform, while CK208-2 covers the 690A/B/C and 695 platforms. Installation time is estimated at 40 hours. Adding the kit will fully comply with the Forestry Service requirements and prepare operators for the 2025 season. The belts are manufactured by Twin Commander sister company ABI, and personalization options are coming soon. You don't have to engage in firefighting operations to add the kit. The FAA estimates that shoulder harnesses reduce serious injury by 50 percent, making them a great safety investment for any owner or operator.
